MASKS ARE REQUIRED ON WESLEYAN COLLEGE'S CAMPUS

All students, faculty, staff, and visitors are required to wear a mask in all public spaces on the Wesleyan College campus, both inside and outside.


Masks are not required outside if there are no other people around, in faculty or staff individual office space if there are no guests, and in residence hall rooms when there are no visitors. However, all individuals should have a mask with them at all times while on campus. Masks should be cloth or procedural masks. Masks with vents are unacceptable.

WHY? Masks with vents/exhalation valves allow unfiltered exhaled air to escape. This is an unacceptable form of source control as a universal mask while at Wesleyan College.
